What the Workshops Include

- A historical introduction to the world and works of Shakespeare
- An introduction to his language (age group appropriate)
- Practical exercises using Shakespeare's texts
- An exploration of how the language works in practice
- Guided rehearsals in groups with step by step direction
- An opportunity to perform, present and reflect

Formats

One facilitator can run a workshop for up to 30 students. For larger groups we recommend adding a second facilitator or splitting students into two groups.
